


40 KNOTS WINERY 2018 Pinot Noir

Grapes: Pinot Noir - Clone 777 - Burgundy, Languedoc

Terroir - Salish Sea: Soils consisting of sandy gravelly marine over sandy gravelly morainal leading to schistic clay at 12-16' depths. Elevation sloping 3° seaward. Hot to moderate day temp, cooling at night from the ocean breeze. Very mild winters, seldom reaching below 0°C.

Farming: VSP (Vertical Shoot Position)/cane pruning (single and double guyot). Sustainable farming methods, no synthetics and minimum organic certified products used.

Wine Making: Cool fermentation. Punch downs. Native fermentation. Hold until cap sunk, pressed off into Burgundy Oak, then malolactic. No alterations. 16 Day Ferment

Tasting Notes: Experience the sensuous balance of silky tannins and romantic spice while sliding into moments of awe. Ripe cherry and toasty notes.
