Demographic Indicator: Estate, Vancouver Island

Varietals: Petit Milo 35%, Epicure 25%, Pinot Noir 6%, Sieg AZ 7957 Rhineland- Palatinate 35%

Harvest: September 22,2021, 22 brix, pH 3.3

Soil: 40 Knots Salish Sea: Glacier deposit, sandy gravelly marine over sandy gravelly morainal leading to Schist clay at 12-16' depths. Elevation sloping from 31m to 11m above sea

Other: Sustainable Farming

Pruning VSP (Vertical Shoot Position): Spur, Cane

Farming: Traditional Sustainable Farming methods. No herbicides. No pesticides. Limited irrigation is required in record high-temperature conditions in June.

Other: Sustainable Farming

Weather: 2021 saw the hottest days of history in Comox hitting 38°c on June 27th, but over 40°c in the vineyard with many other sweltering days from June through August. The average sunlight was between 14 and 16 hours during the growing period with an average monthly precipitation of 3.6cm.

Cellar Notes: 20 day ferment. De-stemmed & medium crush to stainless steel. Inoculated with EC1118, blended, racked and filtered. Matured in stainless steel.

Tasting Notes: Cherry blossom, honey and peach dance out of the glass and onto the palate with a complex finish of guava, elderflower, fig and spice.
